Entry Information: Dogs may enter both the Instinct Test and Novice class in the same trial until the dog has earned the RATN title and then they cannot enter the Instinct Test. Dogs completing the RATN in the morning trial either day may be moved up to Open for the second trial. This is up to the handler and not required. Move-ups will be accepted up until 1/2 hour after the conclusion of Trial 1 each day. Move-up forms will be available at the Secretary's table.

All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. A returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$50 fee for all returned checks. No entries will be taken over the phone or electronically. **Make check payable to CCSC.** Send entries & fees to the trial secretary. Dogs must have a Barn Hunt registration number. Refunds will be made in full if a dog is pulled before the May 25th, 2023, closing date but not after except for a veterinary excuse with documentation

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

General Directions: Take I-70W to 270S > I-44W > MO-100N > MO-MMW

Located just 10 minutes west of Six Flags St. Louis on Highway 44. Take the Gray Summit exit #253 and head North on Highway 100 for 1/2 miles. Take a left and head West on MM for approx. one mile until you reach the Purina Farms entrance on the left-hand side of the road.

RV INFORMATION

Purina Farms offers two options for camping at the facility. A full-service lot with electric/water/sewer hook-ups, and a lot with electric only. The electric only lot has multiple water spigots for filling freshwater tanks, but not for permanent hook up. Cost for the full hook up sites is \$40 per day and electric only sites are \$25 per day. Full hook up sites are available after 3:00 pm on Sunday June 11th. Electric only sites are available Friday June 9th after 3:00 pm.

RV Reservations for Purina Farms will be made directly through Purina Farms. No tent camping is allowed. RVs can be rented from the companies listed on Purina Farms website or from anyone of your choosing. If you rent an RV you will need to remember to also BOOK AN RV SITE!

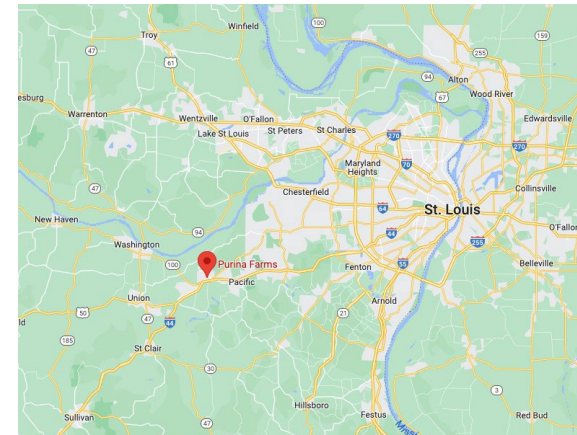

All dogs must be on a short leash and under control while on trial grounds except while showing. **FLEXI LEASHES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE BLINDS OR RINGS.** There is **NO SMOKING** in this facility or on the grounds. If you must smoke, you will need to do so inside your vehicle and dispose of the butts in the vehicle also. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in the regular classes and the Instinct test. Rosettes will be awarded for first through fourth place in Novice through Master. High in Class ribbons and New Title ribbons will be awarded. All qualifiers will receive a 2" bucket of treats. All placements will receive an eartag with logo. All high in class will receive stainless steel bucket.

Note: If you anticipate earning a RATCH, RATCHX, C8 bronze, silver, gold or platinum title at this event email the trial chair at krechols@aol.com when entering so we may order the correct amount of special title ribbons.

Please bring weather appropriate gear. These trials will be a combination of indoors/outdoors depending upon the conditions. There will be indoor crating space available but please make sure your crate is secure as the dogs may be highly excited. Please use a mat underneath your crate.

Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial in panties. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing time of the trial if you wish to withdraw. After the trial closes, entry fees will not be refunded. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the trial and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.

Please bring adequate water for you and your dogs. Lunch will be provided for volunteers. Porta potties will be nearby and there are indoor restrooms at the Purina Event Center.
