Dog Registration:

Dogs **must** be registered with the North American Sport Dog Association and receive a lifetime number at <http://nasda.dog/registration>. Registration is a one-time fee and can be done on site (from your personal cell phone). However, it is recommended that you register your dog before the day of the event, Tuesday June 13, for those planning to enter Day of.

Rules:

For complete rules, visit nasda.dog. See Urban Class section for required leashes or long lines for all Urban Locating classes.

Awards:

Awards will be handed out at the conclusion of the trial. Ribbons are awarded for Qualifying Score, Best of Breed, High in Class and New Title. Each Junior who achieves one or more Qualifying Scores will receive a special award.

Venue:

Exhibitors will be crating in their vehicles. **BTCA** reserves the right to remove any individual for any reason from the premises. No refunds will be issued. Please pack food and water for you and your dog.

Notice to Exhibitors:

- Trials 1, 2, and 3 will run sequentially. If you sign up for all three trials in a class such as Trailing and Locating, you will complete Trial 1 and move immediately with the judge to the location of Trial 2, complete Trial 2 and move on to Trial 3.
- No refunds will be made for cancellations after the closing date or entries which are absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by decision of the Trial Committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and **legible** information on their entry forms.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for behavior of their dogs, children and/or guests. Any exhibitor whose dogs, children and/or guests repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any entry will be made.
- Dogs exhibiting illness, injury, or lameness will be excused. Bitches in season cannot compete.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being in the staging area when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. A declined payment or returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$40 fee for any returned check or payment. Checks must be made payable to **BTCA**.
- **BTCA** reserves the right to refuse any entry without cause or explanation.
