



Running Order: The test committee reserves the right to modify the running order to keep the event running smoothly. Dogs will be run in the order that entries are received with consideration given to dogs being handled by the same handler, except for Master test.

Dogs entered in the Master test must be present at 7:30 a.m. so that braces may be drawn.

It is expressly understood that all entrants have read and are familiar with the "Regulations for Earthdog Tests for Small Terriers and Dachshunds" published by the AKC. A complete copy may be obtained by contacting: AKC, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390.

**Owner Responsibilities:**

Any individual attending a BTCA sanctioned event and staying in a hotel/campsite has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dog(s) on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room/campsite and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite management and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be **subject to any or all of the following actions by the BTCA Board of Directors:**

- \*May be banned from showing at the next BTCA sanctioned event.
- \*May be subject to AKC sanctions.
- \*Membership in the BTCA may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated.

Damages shall be defined as:

Flea infestations, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite property (walls, Bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc)  
Any verified complaint by the hotel/campsite or by a BTCA member.

**BTCA Room Regulations:**

All dogs shall be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner must stay in the room with the dog. Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel/campsite management and to assume complete financial responsibility for that damage. No bathing or grooming of dogs will be allowed in rooms. Dog are allowed to be on hotel furniture/beds only if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by owner. Owners will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at event.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

1. No dogs under 6 months of age will be allowed to enter.
2. No bitches in season will be allowed to run. Entry fees paid for a bitch that comes into season will not be refunded.
3. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred by the Test Committee. No entry fees will be returned if the Test cannot start or be completed due to an Act of God or any cause beyond control of the Test Committee.
4. The owner or handler entering a dog in these Tests does so at his or her own risk and agrees to assume responsibility for any damage caused by him/her or by his/her dog. He/she also agrees to abide by all rules set forth in this Premium list.
5. Barking dogs outside the Test Area are to be removed from the area but not disciplined for barking.
6. No dog will be allowed in the Test Area until its judging time.
7. Lunch break will be at judge's discretion.
8. **USE OF FLEXI-LEADS WITHIN TEST/TRIAL PRECINCT IS PROHIBITED.** The test/trial precincts are within 100 feet of the test area.
